Adaptation: Changing to fit in better with where you live.
Animals might have special things about them that help them survive.

Camouflage: Some animals have colors or patterns on their bodies that make them blend in with their environment, helping them hide from predators or sneak up on their prey.

Endangered: Endangered means there aren't many of that animal left. They need help to stay safe because they might disappear forever.

Glossary

Herbivore: A herbivore is an animal that eats plants only, not meat.

Nocturnal: Nocturnal animals are most active at night. They have special senses to see in the dark.

Prehensile: Prehensile means having a body part that can grab things. Some animals have tails or other body parts they can use like an extra hand.

Arboreal: This means living in trees. Animals that are arboreal spend most of their time climbing, swinging, or resting in the treetops.

Gestation: Gestation is the time when a baby animal is growing inside its mother before it's born.

Symbiotic: Symbiotic is when two different kinds of living things have a close relationship and both benefit from it. It's like teamwork in nature, where each partner helps the other one out.
